

## Educational Gifts

### What are Educational Gifts?

Educational gifts are a wonderful way of helping someone through their educational journey, whether it be an entry level qualification to help kick start their future or a higher level qualification to further their knowledge to design their future.

You may be a parent or grandparent, an aunt or an uncle, a nephew or a niece, a mentor or a teacher, a business or any type of organisation who wishes to help another educationally and financially.

The 'gifter', the person who buys the educational gift, can purchase the full or part of the qualification fee for the 'giftee', the learner, to help them design their future.



### IMPORTANT information about enrolment

All learners that are not 18 years old at the time of enrolling will require an adult to authorise enrolment onto a LVS training course. The adult details will be completed on the enrolment form.

The gifter will:

1. The gifter will have a discussion with the potential learner about the qualification they wish to do
2. The gifter will select and pay for the course in person or electronically (The payment may be full or partial payment and a receipt is always given)
3. LVS Training will issue an 'educational gift voucher' for the value of the gifter's purchase. (The voucher is given to either the gifter or the giftee)
4. The giftee will use the voucher at enrolment for use against their qualification costs, depending on the full or partial payment from the gifter.
5. The giftee starts and completes the course
6. The giftee is issued a certificate for the successful completion of their accredited qualification

### How is the course assessed?

Assessment requirements: Most of the listed qualifications are internally assessed Assessments to measure a learner's skill, knowledge and understanding against the standards set in the qualification specification.

### Achieving this qualification

In most qualifications, each learner will create a portfolio of evidence which may be drawn from actual or simulated situations, which demonstrates achievement of all the learning outcomes and assessment criteria associated with each unit. On completion of each unit learners must declare that the work produced is their own. The main pieces of evidence for the portfolio could include:

- Assessor observation - completed observational checklists and related action plans • witness testimony
- Learner's proof of work • worksheets • assignments/projects/reports • record of professional discussion
- Record of oral and written questioning.

### Entry requirements

There are no specific recommended prior learning requirements for these qualifications. This qualification is suitable for learners aged pre-16 and above, although it is recommended that learners should be aged at least 14.

### Mode of study

A variety of teaching methods are used, dependent upon unit content and learner preferences.

### Progression path

Learners who achieve these qualifications following the successful completion of all learning outcomes, will progress onto the next level to develop their skills, knowledge and understanding.
