The objectives of this qualification

The objective of this qualification is to:

- prepare learners for employment and support them to progress to a teaching role within the workplace.

This qualification aims to meet the needs of a range of trainee teachers, intending to work in the post-16 education and training sector, such as:

- Individuals not currently in a teaching or training role - achievement of the qualification does not require practice other than microteaching unless units from the learning and development suite of qualifications are selected
- Individuals currently teaching and training (including those who have just begun teaching and training) - although the qualification does not require practice other than microteaching (unless units from the learning and development suite of qualifications are selected), opportunities may be made available to observe and provide feedback on a trainee teacher's practice
- Individuals currently working as assessors who wish to achieve a qualification that provides an introduction to teaching

Achieving Qualification

To be awarded this qualification, learners are required to successfully achieve a minimum of 12 credits:

- 3 credits from the mandatory unit in group A

- 6 credits from group B
- 3 credits from group C

Depending upon the optional units chosen, a learner will either need to take part in microteaching (Unit 02) or teaching practice in the work environment (Unit 03 and Unit 04). Therefore, it may be undertaken by individuals who are not in a teaching role if the microteaching option is taken.

Mandatory units (if applicable)

- 3 credits from the mandatory unit in group A

Assessment method (Presenting evidence)

Internally assessed and externally quality assured portfolio of evidence.

Each learner must create a portfolio of evidence generated from appropriate assessment tasks, which demonstrates achievement of all the learning outcomes associated with each unit. On completion of each unit, learners must declare that the work produced is their own and the assessor must countersign this.

The main pieces of evidence for the portfolio could include:

- Assessor observation
- Witness testimony
- Learner's proof of work
- Worksheets
- Assignments/projects/reports
- Record of professional discussion

- Record of oral and written questioning
- Recognition of prior learning (RPL)
- Learner and peer reports

Placement in a Real Work Environment -RWE (if applicable)

No required for trainees with no placement as they can complete unit 02, however, the following optional units are included in this qualification as explained in the achieving qualification section above.

Learners who achieve this qualification could progress to:

- Level 3 Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement
- Level 3 Award in Assessing Competence in the Work Environment
