Objectives of these qualifications

To prepares trainee teachers to teach in a range of contexts. There is a significant practice requirement as this qualification will assess, and provide evidence of, competence when undertaking teaching and/or training responsibilities.

The objective of this qualification is to:

- confirm occupational competence in a teaching role within the workplace

Achieving these qualifications

To be awarded the **NCFE Level 5 Diploma in Teaching (Further Education and Skills)**, learners are required to successfully complete the following mandatory units.



Knowledge only units are indicated by a star. If a unit is not marked with a star, it is a skills unit or contains a mix of knowledge and skills.

To be awarded this qualification, learners are required to successfully achieve all 5 units/90 credits from the mandatory units and at least 3 units/30 credits from the 7 optional units.

Where the assessment requirements for a unit allows, it is essential that organisations wishing to operate a RWE do so in an environment that reflects a real work setting and replicates the key characteristics of the workplace in which the skill to be assessed is normally employed.

Placement

The minimum required placement hours are 250 hours. This must include:

- at least 150 hours of teaching practice, of these:
 - o at least 100 hours must be in the learner's subject area
 - o a minimum of 20 hours of remote synchronous (live) delivery should be included, alongside a minimum of 80 hours face-to-face delivery

Simulation is not permitted for all units.
